1. T Wallet Overview

1.1. Context

Post demonetization, country aims to go cashless. Therefore, need for a digital payment has become imminent. Telangana Sate government has also announced support for cashless transactions in the state. It also wanted its citizens to effortlessly make payments to both government and private services. As a result, Telangana Sate government has come out with new initiative called T Wallet.

1.2. Why T Wallet?

- Existing digital solutions are for smart phone users and thus focus is urban centric.
- There is very limited option for Feature phone and no phone users/ citizens in the rural areas.
- T Wallet is designed with focus on feature phone and no phone users in rural areas.
- Citizens will have more trust being a Government wallet.







2. Highlights of T Wallet

- T wallet is the official digital wallet of Telangana State, which is Any Time Any Where digital payment option for Everyone
- This is the first official e-Wallet from any state Government in India
- T Wallet serves through Online (Desktop, Laptop), Smart Phone, Feature Phone and even no phone
- T Wallet supports payments for both Government and Private transactions
- Citizens with feature phone or no phone can use 4100 Mee Seva centres available across the state to open T Wallet a/c, Load money and make payments through T Wallet. This is a unique proposition.
- Supports Telugu and Urdu besides English
- It is integrated with government departments and corporations such as TSSPDCL, TSNPDCL, HMWSSB, GHMC, CDMA, HMDA ORR Tolls, TASK, 4100 MeeSeva centers and portals.
- No transaction charges for all the Govt. payments such as Electricity Bill, Water Bill, Property Tax, etc.
- Integration is in progress, as part of Phase 2, with Traffic e-challan, TSPSC, Labour department, Streenidhi SHG Loan Repayment and Metro Rail Smart Card for topup
- It is going to be a bi directional wallet wherein in future government benefits such as student scholarships, Aasara Pensions, MNREGA wages can be directly pushed to citizen T Wallet a/c.

3. Core Features of T Wallet

3.1. Registration

In order to use T Wallet, user has to first register with it. If the registration is successful, T Wallet a/c is created for the user. Registration can be done using any one of the following 3 options.
